- Should include your intentions
- Should state the position for which you are applying
- Should include a statement of commitment

Resume

- Name, address, email, and phone numbers (home and cell)
- Sports Played
- Academic Honors
- Athletic Honors
- Any other credentials you feel are important or are of value
Extracurricular, Church, Youth Groups, Family, etc.
- Reference letters may be included

Statement of Goals

- This should include team and individual goals

Action Plan

- How is the team going to reach its goals?
- How are you going to reach your goals?

A list of times you are available for your interview

- What is your work schedule?
- What is your vacation schedule?
- What is your athletic schedule (outside of Lee-Davis High School)?

Be prepared to discuss the following through the interview process (this list is not complete):

- **Your actions.**
- **Your stated goals and your action plan.**
- **The expectations of a captain.**
- **Positive aspects of the program.**
- **Things that need to be improved about the program.**
- **Things that you'd change about the program.**
- **What are the largest obstacles this program faces?**
- **What are the biggest obstacles we have in achieving our goals?**
- **Your qualifications to be a captain.**
- **How will you handle your teammates both on and off the field?**
- **How will you build trust in your teammates and coaches?**

The interviews will be very candid and you will be asked some very challenging questions relating to football and your own personal values. Your answers will reveal your commitment to the program and its values. All of the information shared in the interviews will remain confidential.
